**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** UMBC snapped a four-game slide with 59-51 win over Boston University to earn their first win in conference play this season. Britnie Hughes scored a career-high 16 points to lead UMBC while Matea Pender tallied UMBC's first double-double of the season at 12 points and 12 rebounds. Sharri Rohde finished in double-digits as well with 10 points and career-highs of seven assists and four blocks. The Retrievers ended the first half with a 10-0 run to take a 34-28 lead at halftime and increased their advantage by as many as 14 points in the second stanza. UMBC never trailed in the second half as the Retrievers moved back to .500 at 6-6 on the season with the win.

**NORTHEASTERN UPDATE:** Northeastern enters the game with the exact same record as the Retrievers after defeating Hartford, 58-51, on Wednesday night. The Huskies were led by Marlene Zwarich, who leads the conference at 16.2 ppg, with 21 points. Shaleyse Smallwood scored 14 points in the winning effort as well. Smallwood is second on the team at 13.8 ppg

## QUICK HITS:

### Against Northeastern

\* UMBC's game against Northeastern University marks the fourth meeting between the two programs. Last year in the first meeting UMBC set new single-game shooting marks against the Huskies. The Retrievers' 14 three-point baskets made tied for second in the America East Record books and ranked as a first in the Retrievers all-time chart for made field goals. UMBC shot school records for field goal percentage (67.4 percent on 31-of-46) and three-point percentage (63.6 percent on 14-of-22) as well. The Retrievers lost that game 91-78, but beat NU 61-51 at home before falling in the AE tournament 55-30.

### Retrievers Aim For 200th D-I Win

\* The UMBC Women's Basketball program is on the verge of winning their 200th game during their 19-year Division-I history. The Retrievers last win over Boston U. put them at 199 career win since turning D-I at the start of the 1986-87 season.

### Double-Double

\* Matea Pender recorded UMBC's first double-double since Shalayna Johnson (1999-2003) scored 37 points and 10 rebounds against Quinnipiac on Mar. 1, 2003. Pender finished with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Boston University. Pender's 12 rebounds is the first time this season a Retriever has hit double-digits in rebounds as well.

### Retrievers Open Conference Home Slate With Win

\* UMBC won their first home conference game for the first time in six years with their win over BU, 59-51. UMBC's last conference win in their home opener prior to last Wednesday night was a 62-54 victory over UNC Asheville in 1998, UMBC's last year in the Big South Conference.

### Pender Top Three-Point Shooter In Nation

\* Matea Pender leads the nation in three-point percentage entering the week as the junior guard/forward is shooting 62.5 percent from outside the arc, tops in the latest NCAA Statistics release in games as of Jan. 10, 2005.

### Block Party

\* UMBC in their last five games has 18 blocks as a team, 10 from Sharri Rohde. Rohde set a career-high four blocks against Boston U.

### Pender's lead

\* In UMBC's six wins this season Matea Pender is averaging 19.2 ppg, shooting 54.7 percent from the field (41-of-75) and 64.7 percent from three-point range (22-of-34). In four of those six games Pender has scored 20 or more points. In games lost Pender is averaging 10.3 ppg.

### No Rest For Rohde

\* The past three games Sharri Rohde has played all 40 minutes for the Retrievers as the sophomore guard is averaging 10.7 ppg and shooting 50.0 percent from the floor in conference play. Rohde has 12 rebounds, 12 assists, seven steals and five blocks in UMBC's three conference contests.

### 40-Minute Night

\* Three players play 40-minutes against Stony Brook as Matea Pender, Sharri Rohde and Heather Luttrell all logged the max minutes. The last time UMBC recorded three 40-minute players was against Northeastern on Jan. 17, 2004, one of which was Sharri Rohde.

### Conference Leaders

\* UMBC as a team leads the conference in field goal percentage, three-point field goals made and assists. Matea Pender is the league leader in three-point percentage and three-point field goals made.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his third season with the Retrievers and ninth season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year

with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

# News and Notes ...

**Retrievers in Top-20 in Latest NCAA Statistics Release...**UMBC ranked as a team in the top-20 in the NCAA statistic charts in three-point field goals per game as of games thru Jan. 10, 2005. The Retrievers ranked 16th in three-point field goals per game as a team with a 7.2 average.

**Pender Holds Top Slot on NCAA Charts...**Matea Pender took over the top slot on the NCAA national statistics chart for three-point field goal percentage (62.5 percent) as of games thru Jan. 10, 2005. Pender also ranks 14th in treys per game at 2.7. Pender last week shot 70.0 percent from outside the arc, making 7-of-10 treys.

**Pender joins 30-point night club...**Matea Pender had a career night for UMBC at Stony Brook, scoring a career-high 30 points against the Seawolves on 7-of-15 shooting from the field and 6-of-8 shooting from three-point range. Pender's 30-points rank tied for 11th on UMBC's all-time single-game points scored chart. The last time a UMBC player hit 30-points in a game was Shalayna Johnson on March 1, 2003 when she set the school record with 37 against Quinnipiac.

**Long Range Shooters...**UMBC is becoming well known for their three-point shooting as they lead the league once again in three-point field goals per game. The Retrievers are averaging 7.25 treys per game, tops in the AE charts. UMBC last year set new America East records in their first season in the conference from behind the arc, recording the conference's all-time best three-point field goals made mark at 194 for the season and the attempted mark as well at 578. **Matea Pender** leads UMBC with 32 treys, a 2.67 per game average.

**Pender Named America East Co-Player of the Week For Second Time This Season...**UMBC junior **Matea Pender** was named America East Co-Player of the Week for the week ending Dec. 12, 2004. Pender had a stellar week for the Retrievers dropping double-digits in three-con-

secutive games to up her streak to six-straight double-digit performances and scored her third and fourth 20-plus point performances of the year. Pender on the week shot 58.3 percent from the floor (21-of-36) and an outstanding 72.2 percent from three-point range (13-of-18). Against Lafayette she tallied a career-high six made three-point baskets (6-of-8), netting 22-points, and followed that up going 5-of-6 from behind the arc two nights later against American as she led UMBC with 25-points.

**Retrievers Go With Pender...**UMBC is following the lead of junior **Matea Pender** as the Retrievers are 6-2 in games Pender has scored double-digits. In UMBC wins, Pender is averaging 19.2 ppg, shooting 54.7 percent (41-of-75) from the field and 64.7 percent (22-of-34) from three-point range. Pender already has five 20-point plus performances, topping last season's one 20-point performance the entire year. **Courtney Doughman** produced that performance with a 22-point effort against Albany.

**Retrievers Dial Long Distance...**UMBC's 11 three-point baskets against Lafayette and their 11 versus Morgan State was three treys off their school record of 14 set by the Retrievers last year at Northeastern. UMBC has hit double-digits in three-point field goals made on three occasions this season.

**Retrievers Showing Unselfish Play...**UMBC as a team recorded 20 assists or more in four games this season, eclipsing their total amount of assists in any one game all of last year with 21 in each of the first two. Against Lafayette UMBC set a season-high 23 assists as a team. Leading the way is **Sharri Rohde** with 45 assists on the season and **Brittanie Hughes** with 44. UMBC's school record for team assists in a game is 27. The Retrievers are averaging 16.58 assists per game, ranking first in the America East team statistics charts. UMBC ranks second in assist/turnover ratio in the AE charts at 0.99.
