RETRIEVER UPDATE: In what turned out to be a losing effort to New Hampshire, 73-61, Anastasia Goncharova turned in the best performance by a UMBC player off the bench and one of the best performance in the program's history with 33 points on 12-of-13 shooting from the field and 9-of-10 from three-point range. Goncharova hit 6-of-6 in the first half to score 18 of UMBC's 29 points at the break. The Retrievers, however, were unable to account for a 14-0 run in the second half by the visiting Wildcats and fell for the fourth time in the last five outings. Goncharova's 33 points is the sixth best performance in a single game for points scored in UMBC history and her nine three-point baskets were one off the all-time record for treys in a game.

VERMONT UPDATE: Despite their latest loss to league leader Hartford, the Catamounts are off to a strong start in league play with a 5-3 mark heading into the final game before the halfway point in league play. Vermont is led by Lani Boardman with 15.5 ppg and Kate McNamara with 11.3 ppg. Vermont leads the conference in scoring at 67.4 ppg.

Who's Up Next: The Retrievers begin the second half of conference play with Stony Brook at home on Saturday, Feb. 5 at 7 p.m. in UMBC RAC Arena.

QUICK HITS:

Against Vermont

* The all-time series between UMBC and Vermont is knotted at 1-1 after splitting last year, each holding their own on their home court. UMBC earned their first win of the season against the Catamounts last year, a 10-point win, while Vermont at home downed UMBC by 22 points in the rematch.

Match-up Notes

* Vermont enters the game with the top scoring offense in the league at 67.4 ppg while UMBC has fallen to 10th at 56.4 ppg. The game pits two of the top scorers in the conference, as Lani Boardman of Vermont is averaging 15.5 ppg while UMBC's Matea Pender is averaging 14.5 ppg and leads the conference in three-point field goal percentage.

Getting Ahead

* UMBC has had trouble after falling behind this year showing their need to get ahead early on. UMBC when trailing at halftime is 1-7 this year and are 0-7 when trailing with 10 minutes left in the game. The Retrievers are 6-3 when leading with 10 and five minutes left in the game and 5-2 when leading at halftime, showing the ability to sustain leads once ahead.

Pender Top Three-Point Shooter In Nation For Fourth Week In A Row

* Matea Pender in the latest NCAA statistics which run thru games as of Jan. 31, 2005, leads the nation in three-point percentage at 53.9 percent. It is the fourth week in a row this season that Pender has led the NCAA in three-point field goal percentage. Pender heading into the week has made 41-of-76 from three-point land. In games won this year Matea has converted 24 of her 41 total three-pointers on the year.

Double-Double

* Just two games after recording UMBC's first double-double since Shalayna Johnson (1999-2003) scored 37 points and 10 rebounds against Quinnipiac on Mar. 1, 2003, Matea Pender recorded her second one of the season against Albany with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Pender finished with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Boston University two games prior. Pender's 12 rebounds is a career-high for her.

Goncharova's Career-Day

* Anastasia Goncharova recorded career numbers against New Hampshire, posting 33 points on 9-of-10 shooting from the three-point arc and 12-of-13 from the field. Goncharova finished last week shooting 78.9 percent from the field (15-of-19) and 73.3 percent from three-point range (11-of-15) for a 20.5 ppg average.

Goncharova's Day

-Nine three-point baskets ties conference mark for treys in a game.

-Nine three-point baskets is one off the UMBC record for three-pointers in a game. Jami Lange holds the UMBC record of 10 set on Feb. 22, 1999 against Long Island.

-Nine Three-point field goals in the most treys connected in the least amount of attempts (10).

-33 points scored is most by a UMBC women's basketball player off the bench.

-33 points scored is the sixth most points scored in a game in Retriever women's basketball program history.

Pender's lead

* In UMBC's seven wins this season Matea Pender is averaging 19.1 ppg, shooting 53.5 percent from the field (46-of-86) and 64.9 percent from three-point range (24-of-37). In four of those six games Pender has scored 20 or more points. In games lost Pender is averaging 11.3 ppg.

UMBC's 13 treys One Off School Mark

* UMBC's 13 three-point field goals was one three-point basket from tying the single-game mark for tri-fectas in a contest in UMBC history. Last year UMBC set the mark at 14 against Northeastern. UMBC's first eight field goals were treys and nine of UMBC's 10 first half field goals were from outside the arc against New Hampshire.

Senior Tyecia Powell Out For Remainder Of Season

* Senior Tyecia Powell suffered a season ending knee injury at Albany and will miss the remainder of her senior year. Powell, a 5-11 center, started all 19 conference games last year but has been limited in her action prior to her injury this season.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his third season with the Retrievers and ninth season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year

with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

News and Notes ...

Pender Holds Top Slot on NCAA Charts...Matea Pender held her top slot on the NCAA national statistics chart for three-point field goal percentage (53.9 percent) as of games thru Jan. 31, 2005. Pender also ranks 35th in treys per game at 2.4. Pender has led the nation in three-point field goal percentage for four weeks straight.

Retrievers Capture 200th D-I Win...The UMBC Women's Basketball program won their 200th game during their 19-year Division-I history. The Retrievers last win over Binghamton put them at 200 career win since turning D-I at the start of the 1986-87 season.

Long Range Shooters...UMBC is becoming well known for their three-point shooting as they lead the league once again in three-point field goals per game. The Retrievers are averaging 6.9 treys per game, tops in the AE charts. UMBC last year set new America East records in their first season in the conference from behind the arc, recording the conference's all-time best three-point field goals made mark at 194 for the season and the attempted mark as well at 578. **Matea Pender** leads UMBC with 41 treys, a 2.41 per game average.

Retrievers Open Conference Home Slate With Win...UMBC won their first home conference game for the first time in six years with their win over BU, 59-51. UMBC's last conference win in their home opener prior to last Wednesday night was a 62-54 victory over UNC Asheville in 1998, UMBC's last year in the Big South Conference.

Pender and Goncharova join UMBC's 30-point game club...Matea Pender and Anastasia Goncharova each have had a career games for UMBC this year. Pender at Stony Brook, scored a career-high 30 points against the Seawolves on 7-of-15 shooting from the field and 6-of-8 shooting from three-point range. Pender's 30-points rank tied for 12th on UMBC's all-time single-game points scored chart. Goncharova against New Hampshire topped Pender's performance with 33 points on 12-of-13 shooting from the field and 9-of-10 from three-point range. The last time a UMBC player prior to this season hit 30-points in a game was Shalayna

Johnson on March 1, 2003 when she set the school record with 37 against Quinnipiac.

Rohde Drops Career High

* Sharri Rohde scored a career-high 18 points in UMBC's outing against Albany, topping her old mark of 17 points set her freshman year against Loyola (Md.). Rohde went 5-of-8 from the field and connected on 6-of-6 from the charity stripe.

Pender Named America East Co-Player of the Week For Second Time This Season...UMBC junior **Matea Pender** was named America East Co-Player of the Week for the week ending Dec. 12, 2004. Pender had a stellar week for the Retrievers dropping double-digits in three-consecutive games to up her streak to six-straight double-digit performances and scored her third and fourth 20-plus point performances of the year. Pender on the week shot 58.3 percent from the floor (21-of-36) and an outstanding 72.2 percent from three-point range (13-of-18). Against Lafayette she tallied a career-high six made three-point baskets (6-of-8), netting 22-points, and followed that up going 5-of-6 from behind the arc two nights later against American as she led UMBC with 25-points.

Retrievers Go With Pender...UMBC is following the lead of junior **Matea Pender** as the Retrievers are 7-5 in games Pender has scored double-digits. In UMBC wins, Pender is averaging 19.1 ppg, shooting 53.5 percent (46-of-86) from the field and 64.9 percent (24-of-37) from three-point range.
