**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** The Retrievers rallied from a 20-point deficit and a 30-12 halftime deficit with 42 second half points as the Retrievers came back to tie the game 53-53 before Boston U. held on in the final two minutes for the 61-54 victory. Junior Matea Pender scored 23 second-half point and 24 in the game as the Retrievers charged back in the second period with 24-7 run. Erin Voss finished with a career-high 15 points on 7-of-10 shooting from the field, including knocking down a three-point basket. Pender recorded her third double-double of the year by tying her career-high of 12 rebounds. Pender started the game 0-for-6 from the field in the opening stanza before going 7-of-12 in the second period, including hitting a trey at the 1:53 mark to tie the game 53-53. UMBC shot 37 percent in the game 17-of-46, but 52.2 percent in the second half on 12-of-23.

**Northeastern UPDATE:** The Huskies currently are one rung above the Retrievers in the conference standings after falling to conference leader Hartford on Wednesday night by a 83-58 decision. The Huskies are led by Marlene Zwarich who ranks as one of the conference leaders in scoring at 17.9 ppg. Freshman Shaleyse Smallwood averages 14.8 ppg and has racked up seven conference weekly honors.

**Who's Up Next:** The Retrievers return home for a four game homestand starting with Binghamton on Feb. 16.

## QUICK HITS:

### Against Northeastern

\* UMBC trails in the all-time series to Northeastern 3-1 and won the first regular season game this season on the Retrievers' home court. UMBC's lone win in the series came in the second meeting with the Huskies last season. Northeastern has won two in a row against UMBC.

### Match-up Notes

\* The Retrievers versus Northeastern match-up features two of the top conference players in Maralene Zwarich of Northeastern and UMBC's Matea Pender. Zwarich is averaging 17.3 ppg and shooting 45.5 percent from the field while Pender enters the week leading the nation in three-point field goal percentage for the fifth week in a row and is averaging 14.9 ppg. Northeastern has three players averaging in double-figures as Shaleyse Smallwood (14.8 ppg) and Francesca Vanin (10.2 ppg) rank second and third respectively.

### Last Meeting

\* In the last meeting Northeastern held off UMBC down the stretch as Maralene Zwarich, with the shot clock winding down, pulled up for a jumper at the free throw line pushing the game back to a two possession deficit and the Huskies sneaking away with a 58-52 win. Matea Pender finished with 20 points and Brittanie Hughes scored 10 points for UMBC while Zwarich tallied 23 points and Michelle Decerbo and Shaleyse Smallwood scored 14 points each.

### At Solomon Court

\* UMBC in their only appearance at Northeastern's Solomon Court set school shooting records in a single game, going 67.4 percent from the field making 31-of-46 field goals and shooting 63.6 percent from three-point range making 14-of-22 treys. UMBC's 14 treys is a school record for three-point baskets scored in a single-game. Heather Luttrell went 5-of-5 from outside the arc setting a new school mark for three-point field goal percentage in a game.

### Getting Ahead

\* UMBC has had trouble after falling behind this year showing their need to get ahead early on. UMBC when trailing at halftime is 1-10 this year and are 0-10 when

trailing with 10 minutes left in the game. The Retrievers are 6-3 when leading with 10 and five minutes left in the game and 5-2 when leading at half-time, showing the ability to sustain leads once ahead.

### Pender Top Three-Point Shooter In Nation For Fifth Week In A Row

\* Matea Pender in the latest NCAA statistics which run thru games as of Feb. 6, 2005, leads the nation in three-point percentage at 52.9 percent. It is the fifth week in a row this season that Pender has led the NCAA in three-point field goal percentage. Pender heading into the week has made 45-of-85 from three-point land. In games won this year Matea has converted 24 of her 41 total three-pointers on the year.

### Goncharova's Career-Day

\* Anastasia Goncharova recorded career numbers against New Hampshire, posting 33 points on 9-of-10 shooting from the three-point arc and 12-of-13 from the field. Goncharova finished last week shooting 78.9 percent from the field (15-of-19) and 73.3 percent from three-point range (11-of-15) for a 20.5 ppg average.

### Goncharova's Day

-Nine three-point baskets ties conference mark for treys in a game.

-Nine three-point baskets is one off the UMBC record for three-pointers in a game. Jami Lange holds the UMBC record of 10 set on Feb. 22, 1999 against Long Island.

-Nine Three-point field goals in the most treys connected in the least amount of attempts (10).

-33 points scored is most by a UMBC women's basketball player off the bench.

-33 points scored is the sixth most points scored in a game in Retriever women's basketball program history.

### Pender's lead

\* In UMBC's seven wins this season Matea Pender is averaging 19.1 ppg, shooting 53.5 percent from the field (46-of-86) and 64.9 percent from three-point range (24-of-37). In four of those six games Pender has scored 20 or more points. In games lost Pender is averaging 12.5 ppg.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his third season with the Retrievers and ninth season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year

with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

## News and Notes ...

**Pender Holds Top Slot on NCAA Charts...**Matea Pender held her top slot on the NCAA national statistics chart for three-point field goal percentage (52.9 percent) as of games thru Feb. 6, 2005. Pender also ranks 40th in treys per game at 2.4. Pender has led the nation in three-point field goal percentage for five weeks straight.

**Retrievers Capture 200th D-I Win...**The UMBC Women's Basketball program won their 200th game during their 19-year Division-I history. The Retrievers last win over Binghamton put them at 200 career win since turning D-I at the start of the 1986-87 season.

**Double-Double...**Just two games after recording UMBC's first double-double since Shalayna Johnson (1999-2003) scored 37 points and 10 rebounds against Quinnipiac on Mar. 1, 2003, Matea Pender recorded her second one of the season against Albany with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Pender finished with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Boston University two games prior. Pender in the second meeting against Boston U. recorded her third double-double of the year with 24 points and 12 rebounds.

**Retrievers Open Conference Home Slate With Win...**UMBC won their first home conference game for the first time in six years with their win over BU, 59-51. UMBC's last conference win in their home opener prior to last Wednesday night was a 62-54 victory over UNC Asheville in 1998, UMBC's last year in the Big South Conference.

**Pender and Goncharova join UMBC's 30-point game club...**Matea Pender and Anastasia Goncharova each have had a career games for UMBC this year. Pender at Stony Brook, scored a career-high 30 points against the Seawolves on 7-of-15 shooting from the field and 6-of-8 shooting from three-point range. Pender's 30-points rank tied for 12th on UMBC's all-time single-game points scored chart. Goncharova against New Hampshire topped Pender's performance with 33 points on 12-of-13 shooting from the field and 9-of-10 from three-point range. The last time a UMBC player prior to this season hit 30-points in a game was Shalayna Johnson on March 1, 2003 when she set the school record with 37 against Quinnipiac.

**Pender Named America East Co-Player of the Week For Second Time This Season...**UMBC junior **Matea Pender** was named America East Co-Player of the Week for the week ending Dec. 12, 2004. Pender had a stellar week for the Retrievers dropping double-digits in three-consecutive games to up her streak to six-straight double-digit performances and scored her third and fourth 20-plus point performances of the year. Pender on the week shot 58.3 percent from the floor (21-of-36) and an outstanding 72.2 percent from three-point range (13-of-18). Against Lafayette she tallied a career-high six made three-point baskets (6-of-8), netting 22-points, and followed that up going 5-of-6 from behind the arc two nights later against American as she led UMBC with 25-points.

**Retrievers Go With Pender...**UMBC is following the lead of junior **Matea Pender** as the Retrievers are 7-6 in games Pender has scored double-digits. In UMBC wins, Pender is averaging 19.1 ppg, shooting 53.5 percent (46-of-86) from the field and 64.9 percent (24-of-37) from three-point range. Pender has seven 20-point plus performances, topping last season's one 20-point performance the entire year. **Courtney Doughman** produced that performance with a 22-point effort against Albany.

**Retrievers Dial Long Distance...**UMBC's 13 three-point baskets against New Hampshire was one trey off their school record of 14 set by the Retrievers last year at Northeastern. UMBC has hit double-digits in three-point field goals made on four occasions this season.

**Retrievers Showing Unselfish Play...**UMBC as a team recorded 20 assists or more in five games this season, eclipsing their total amount of assists in any one game all of last year with 21 in each of the first two. Against Lafayette UMBC set a season-high 23 assists as a team. **Brittanie Hughes** (68 assists) and **Sharri Rohde** (66 assists) are the catalysts of the Retrievers offense. UMBC's school record for team assists in a game is 27. The Retrievers are averaging 15.44 assists per game, ranking first in the America East team statistics charts. UMBC ranks second in assist/turnover ratio in the AE charts at 0.93.
