RETRIEVER UPDATE: The Retrievers fell to local foe Navy in their most recent outing by a final score of 60-41. UMBC, after trailing by as many as 13 in the first half, climbed back to come within two points of the Midshipmen before a late run by Navy pushed the game back to double-digits. Retriever guard's **Mariana Santos** and **Anastasia Goncharova** each scored 10 points while sophomore **Maria Brown** held Navy's top threat scoreless during the first 15 minutes of the second half as UMBC made their run. Freshman **Sharri Rohde** came close to a double-double with nine points and eight rebounds.

TOWSON UPDATE: The Tigers are off to a strong start this season opening the year 3-1 with wins over North Carolina Asheville, Robert Morris and Army. The Tigers most recently came from behind to deal Army its first loss of the season and break their five-game win streak. **Kacy O'Brien** has been the Tigers biggest threat, averaging 18.8 points per game to start the season. Towson has three athletes in double figures in scoring as **Kelli Talbot** (13.5 ppg) and **Kelly Robinson** (11.8 ppg) join O'Brien at the top of the Tigers scoring chart.

Who's Up Next: The Retrievers will be back in action at RAC Arena on Dec. 18 when they host American University at 7 p.m. The Retrievers and Eagles met last season with UMBC taking a 56-47 win.

Phil Stern has developed a reputation as a coach who takes struggling programs and skyrockets them to the top of their conference. In his first season at UMBC in 2002-03, he certainly did not disappoint. Last season, Stern led the Retrievers to their first ever conference championship game, just a year after the team failed to even qualify for the eight-team tournament. Stern's squad, after learning his system of play, made great strides, finishing the season ranked as one of the top ball handling and defensive teams in the country. The Retrievers ranked third in the NCAA last season in turnovers per game (12.1) compared to 48th in 2001-02 and finished last year 10th overall in scoring defense (55.2 ppg) in the NCAA as opposed to 32nd in 2001-02. Stern's recent success does not just date back to last season as Stern, prior to his arrival at UMBC, spent four seasons at the University of South Carolina-Aiken (Division II), where he revitalized a floundering program, going 64-47 with the Lady Pacers and earning WBCA District III Coach of the Year while taking his squad to the NCAA Division II Tournament.

RETRIEVER GAMESNOTES

All-time Series vs. Towson: UMBC and Towson have a long standing rivalry in women's basketball that has spanned over five different decades and dates back to 1968-69. While the Tigers took control of the all-time series from the start, winning the first 15 games of the series, UMBC has been on the upper end lately, holding a five-game win streak over their cross-town rival. The series since UMBC's first win in 1985, has been rather equal with Towson holding a 12-10 advantage. UMBC is 6-11 all-time at home vs. the Tigers.

Former BIG South Foe's Reunite...In July of 1992 UMBC and Towson joined the Big South Conference together and started a new era in their storied histories as with the move to the same conference assured that the cross-town rivals would meet at least twice a year. The Tigers were 6-1 against UMBC during their three-year stay in the Big South. Neither team remains in the Big South with Towson a current member of the Colonial Athletic Conference and UMBC in its first year in the America East.

Rookies Coming To Play...The freshman class this season has put together solid numbers for the Retrievers in their debut, averaging 29.7 percent of the Retriever total scoring. **Sharri Rohde**, who leads the team in rebounding average, tallied nine points and eight boards against Navy and eight points and eight boards against the No. 13 UNC Tar Heels. **Heather Luttrell** posted a team game-high 11 points in the opener and **Courtney Doughman** add seven in the Retrievers game against Iona.

From Down Town...The Retrievers have been willing to live by the three or die by the three, taking a 91 total three point attempts through their first four games. Three point attempts con-

stitute 51.4 percent of the Retrievers total field goal attempts (177). The Retrievers are shooting 28.6 percent from beyond the arc. UMBC's 78 points off of three-point baskets equals just over half of their total scoring. **Anastasia Goncharova** has the Retrievers' most three-point buckets with 12 on the year, shooting 37.5 percent from three-point land. Goncharova scored a game-high 18 points in the loss to No. 13 North Carolina. Goncharova hit six treys in the game. Goncharova buried four more three-pointers against Iona to lead the Retrievers in scoring with 12 points in that game.

Getting The Nod...Head Coach **Phil Stern** gave freshman **Sharri Rohde** the starting nod in each of the Retrievers first four games as she earned her first collegiate start at the Retriever Tip-Off Tournament. Rohde logged a season-high 35 minutes against Navy last week. Teammate and fellow freshman **Heather Luttrell** broke into the starting lineup for the first time at UNC to give the Retrievers two rookies on the floor to open the game. Prior to UNC, the Retrievers had not started two freshman since the 2001-02 season when current Retriever **Matea Pender** earned all-rookie team honors.

Rohde Nears First Double-Double...Freshman standout **Sharri Rohde** almost got her first double-double of the year against Navy as she tallied nine points and eight rebounds. Rohde leads the Retrievers in rebounding average (6.0) and has grabbed eight boards in each of the last two games. Rohde scoring average has also started to rise as she ranks third on the team in points per game (5.5).

Phil Stern Era Moves Into Second Season...Head coach **Phil Stern** has begun the second season in his tenure at the helm of the Retriever women's hoops program. Stern in his first season took the Retrievers to the conference title game for the first-time ever and posted a 14-16 record. Stern, known to revitalize struggling programs, continues to build for the future, bringing in six newcomers this year and signing three to National Letters of Intent for the 2004-05 campaign.

Starting From Scratch...With the departure of all-five starters from last year's squad, **Phil Stern** will be looking for players to step up into the starting roll this year. Out of the six returning players, the Retrievers have a total of 26 starts combined prior to the start of the 2003-04 campaign, an average of 4.33 starts per player. **Matea Pender** returns with the most total starts after earning the nod in 18 games her freshman year in 2001-02 before sitting out last season with a knee injury. **Anastasia Goncharova** has the most starts under head coach **Phil Stern** with four last year in 27 games played.

Taking Care Of The Rock...The Retrievers had their best game of taking care of the ball against Navy last week, coughing up the ball just 12 times. UMBC allowed turnovers to plagued their offense early this season as the squad has averaged 23.0 turnovers per game through the first three games. UMBC finished third in the nation last season with a mere 12.1 turnovers per game.

No Charity Allowed...The Retrievers have kept their hands to themselves averaging 9.75 fouls per game. UMBC finished fifth in the nation last year in fouls per game at 13.5. The Retrievers have allowed just seven points per game from the charity stripe.

Retrievers New Beast In The America East...The Retrievers will make their first appearance in the America East this season as UMBC moves into the conference with all its 20-intercollegiate sports. Prior to this year, UMBC spent five seasons in the Northeast Conference and six in the Big South Conference. At the end of last season, the America East had a Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) of 23 compared to 31 held by the NEC (second lowest).

Going Global...The Retrievers' 12-player roster contains three international players. The team's lone senior **Mariana Santos** is from Brazil while sophomore **Matea Pender** is a native of Croatia and junior **Anastasia Goncharova** is from Russia.

RETRIEVER GAMENOTES

In addition to players from the around the world, the majority of UMBC's squad is from outside the state lines. **Maria Brown** (Frederick, Md.) and **Tyecia Powell** (Baltimore, Md.) are the Retrievers' women's hoops only Maryland natives.

Stern Carries Color Commentary...Head coach **Phil Stern** carried the color commentary at the UMBC men's basketball game against Princeton University back on Dec. 2 at UMBC RAC Arena. Stern joined play-by-play man Gary Stein on the airwaves. Stern is a master of the famed Princeton-style offense and gave substantial in depth insight into the system of play during WJFK's broadcast.

Hitting The Airwaves...UMBC will be featured on the airwaves a couple times this season. The Retrievers make their first appearance with a TV game on Saturday, Jan. 10 when they play Hartford at 12 p.m. on Comcast Sportsnet. WJFK-AM, THE JOCK will broadcast the first end of a men and women's doubleheader on Wed., Feb. 4 as veteran broadcasters **Gary Stein** and **Paul Mittermeier** will handle the play-by-play

and analyst duties respectively. The Retrievers women's hoops can also be caught on Teamline on six different occasions. Teamline can be accessed through the basketball home page and is a free service provided by UMBC Athletics.

Leaders Of The Pack...UMBC head coach Phil Stern announced that junior **Tyecia Powell** and sophomore **Betsy Butterick** will be the captains for the 2003-04 season.

UMBC Picked 10th in Preseason Conference Poll...UMBC was picked to finish in last place in the preseason conference polled release by the America East Conference. Maine was a unanimous pick for the top spot receiving nine first place votes. Boston University was selected second followed by Vermont. UMBC, who is entering their first season in the AEC, did not place anyone on the preseason all-conference team.

Retrievers Ink Three For 2004-05...UMBC head women's basketball coach Phil Stern announced the signings of three student-athletes to National Letters of Intent to attend UMBC for the 2004-05 academic year. The list includes Indiana natives **Kristin Drabyn** (Avon, Ind./Avon) and **Jennifer Ferguson** (Fremont, Ind./Fremont) along with local talent **Morgan Hatten** (Potomac, Md./Winston Churchill).

From The Training Room...Retriever freshman **Brittanie Hughes** (stress fracture) will be inactive for Tuesday night's game. Hughes' injury occurred during the preseason practices and has not dressed for a game this season.
