RETRIEVER UPDATE: The Retrievers, who in their previous four games lost by an average of 5.5 ppg, ended a seven-game skid with a 69-53 win over Albany last Saturday night at UMBC RAC Arena. The game marked UMBC's first win over the Great Danes in their short lived all-time series as the Retrievers jumped out to a 26-21 lead at halftime following the strong play from Amanda Robinson off the bench. Robinson in the first half tallied eight UMBC points helping the Retrievers go from a six-point deficit to an five point lead prior to the break. In the second half Matea Pender scored 15 of her game-high 18 points including 4-of-4 from outside the arc allowing the Retrievers to score 43 second-half points and take the 69-53 win. Four Retrievers finished with double-digits in the scoring columns as Pender tallied 18, Robinson 13 points and Brittanie Hughes and Sharri Rohde each scoring 12 points. Hughes and Rohde each have a three-game double-digit scoring streak going. Heather Luttrell led UMBC with nine rebounds and five assists as the Retrievers dished out 22 helpers in the game.

CATAMOUNT UPDATE: Vermont since their win over UMBC in the first meeting has dropped four of five contests yet still remains fixed at fourth place in the conference standings due to their solid 6-3 start. Lani Boardman leads Vermont with 15.3 ppg followed by Katie McNamara at 10.6 ppg. In their last outing Vermont lost to New Hampshire 65-55.

Who's Up Next: The Retrievers play their final home game of the season as the Retrievers host Senior Day on Feb. 26 at 12 p.m. against Hartford. The game will air on AE TV.

QUICK HITS:

Against Vermont

* UMBC's only win out of three attempts game at home last year as the Retrievers won their first America East Conference game with a 65-55 win over the Catamounts. Since that win Vermont has won back-to-back games and holds the all-time series at 2-1. Vermont won the earlier meeting this season 55-27.

Match-up Notes

* The Retrievers versus Vermont match-up focuses on outside the arc as Vermont and UMBC rank one and two respectively in three-point field goals per game. Vermont enters the game leading the conference with an average of 7.13 treys per game with 164 on the year while UMBC ranks second at 6.74 three-point baskets per game and 155 on the season. UMBC features Matea Pender who ranks second in the nation in three-point field goal percentage at 52.3 percent.

Last Meeting

* UMBC suffered their worst scoring output in their D-I era in a 55-27 defeat to Vermont last Wednesday night. UMBC, who entered the game second in the league in scoring and first three-point field goals per game, went 13-of-50 from the field and 0-of-12 from three-point range. The game also marked the first time this season the Retrievers have not hit double-digits in assists, finishing as a team with eight helpers. UMBC also was unable to make it to the foul line until 24 seconds left in the game as Kristin Drabyn was fouled upon making her lay-up. She hit UMBC's only charity stripe attempt in the game. Matea Pender finished with six points and seven rebounds to lead UMBC. For Vermont, Chrissy Battram scored a game-high 12 points.

UMBC Takes On Top-Five In Conference Down The Stretch

* The way the league is panning out this year UMBC has drawn the short straw heading into the final five games of the season of playing the top-five teams in the conference standings, almost in exact ascending order. UMBC when they hosted Albany was ranked fifth in the conference standings as the Retrievers pulled out a 69-53 win. UMBC's next opponent is Vermont (fourth), followed by Hartford (second), before traveling to New Hampshire (third) and Maine (first) to end the season. Facing the top teams in the league to end the season will challenge UMBC has all

10 teams make the league tournament with the bottom four play on opening night to play-in to the quarterfinal round.

Rohde Leads League In Free Throw Percentage In Conference Play

* Sophomore Sharri Rohde leads the league in free throw percentage in conference play, having hit 32-of-33 attempts from the charity stripe over the league's first 14 games. Rohde is an impressive 97.0 percent from the free throw line after making a career-high 8-of-8 free throws in the second meeting against Binghamton and 2-of-2 in the last outing versus Albany.

Rohde Emerging As Defensive Specialist

* Sophomore Sharri Rohde, who normally garners the task of guarding the opponent's top player, has emerged as a defensive force. Rohde currently ranks in overall America East statistics in 3rd place in steals at 1.87 spg and 8th in block shots at 0.87 bpg. In America East Conference games Rohde is tied for first in steals at 2.00 spg with NU's Marlene Zwarich and ranks 9th in blocks at 0.79 bpg.

Pender Ranks Second In Nation Three-Point Field Goal Percentage Chart

* Matea Pender in the latest NCAA statistics which run thru games as of Feb. 20, 2005, moved back up to second after falling to third last week in three-point percentage. Pender led the nation in three-point field goal percentage for five straight weeks and enters this week shooting 52.3 percent from the field at 58-of-111.

Getting Ahead

* UMBC has had trouble after falling behind this year showing their need to get ahead early on. UMBC when trailing at halftime is 1-10 this year and are 0-10 when trailing with 10 minutes left in the game. The Retrievers are 7-3 when leading with five minutes left in the game and 6-4 when leading at halftime, showing the ability to sustain leads once ahead.

Pender's lead

* In UMBC's eight wins this season Matea Pender is averaging 19.0 ppg, shooting 52.9 percent from the field (55-of-99) and 65.9 percent from three-point range (29-of-44). In four of those eight games Pender has scored 20 or more points. In games lost Pender is averaging 12.3 ppg.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his third season with the Retrievers and ninth season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year

with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

News and Notes ...

Pender Back To No. 2 Ranking on NCAA Charts...Matea Pender has moved back up to No. 2 in the NCAA national statistics chart for three-point field goal percentage as of games thru Feb. 20, 2005. Pender, who held the top spot in the nation for five consecutive weeks, is shooting 52.3 percent from outside the arc. Pender also ranks 23rd in treys per game at 2.5.

Goncharova's Career-Day

* Anastasia Goncharova recorded career numbers against New Hampshire, posting 33 points on 9-of-10 shooting from the three-point arc and 12-of-13 from the field. Goncharova finished last week shooting 78.9 percent from the field (15-of-19) and 73.3 percent from three-point range (11-of-15) for a 20.5 ppg average.

Goncharova's Day

-Nine three-point baskets ties conference mark for treys in a game.

-Nine three-point baskets is one off the UMBC record for three-pointers in a game. Jami Lange holds the UMBC record of 10 set on Feb. 22, 1999 against Long Island.

-Nine Three-point field goals in the most treys connected in the least amount of attempts (10).

-33 points scored is most by a UMBC women's basketball player off the bench.

-33 points scored is the sixth most points scored in a game in Retriever women's basketball program history.

Double-Double...Just two games after recording UMBC's first double-double since Shalayna Johnson (1999-2003) scored 37 points and 10 rebounds against Quinnipiac on Mar. 1, 2003, Matea Pender recorded her second one of the season against Albany with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Pender finished with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Boston University two games prior. Pender's in the second meeting with Boston U., recorded her third double-double of the season with 24 points and 12 rebounds.

Pender and Goncharova join UMBC's 30-point game club...Matea Pender and Anastasia Goncharova each have had a career games for UMBC this year. Pender at Stony Brook, scored a career-high 30 points against the Seawolves on 7-of-15 shooting from the field and 6-of-8 shooting from three-point range. Pender's 30-points rank tied for 12th on UMBC's all-time single-game points scored chart. Goncharova against New Hampshire topped Pender's performance with 33 points on 12-of-13 shooting

from the field and 9-of-10 from three-point range. The last time a UMBC player prior to this season hit 30-points in a game was Shalayna Johnson on March 1, 2003 when she set the school record with 37 against Quinnipiac.

Pender Named America East Co-Player of the Week For Second Time This Season...UMBC

junior **Matea Pender** was named America East Co-Player of the Week for the week ending Dec. 12, 2004. Pender had a stellar week for the Retrievers dropping double-digits in three-consecutive games to up her streak to six-straight double-digit performances and scored her third and fourth 20-plus point performances of the year. Pender on the week shot 58.3 percent from the floor (21-of-36) and an outstanding 72.2 percent from three-point range (13-of-18). Against Lafayette she tallied a career-high six made three-point baskets (6-of-8), netting 22-points, and followed that up going 5-of-6 from behind the arc two nights later against American as she led UMBC with 25-points.

20 Field Goals Made/20 Assists...UMBC against Navy recorded an assist on all 20 of their field goals made for a 100.0 percent assist to field goal percentage. **Brittanie Hughes** led UMBC with seven assists in the game. The NCAA record for assist to field goal's made is 32 assists on 32 field goals set in 1986 by St. Louis against Loyola (Ill.).

Rookies Take A Seat...For the first time since the Retrievers' NEC title game at the end of the 2002-03 season, a UMBC freshman did not record any playing time as UMBC against Stony Brook played all upper classmen the entire game. The game broke a span of 38 games where a freshman had recorded playing time.

Hughes Named to All-Tournament Team...Sophomore **Brittanie Hughes** was named to the UMBC Retriever Tip-Off Tournament All-Tournament team after finishing the opening weekend with 9.0 ppg and 6.0 apg. Hughes also stole seven balls. Hughes set a career-high for points in a game in the first half against Coppin State and went on to set her new mark at 12 points.

UMBC Reaches Five Wins the Fastest in D-I Era...The Retrievers with their 67-49 win over American reached five wins the fastest in the Retrievers' program Division-I history. UMBC had four wins in their first six games this season entering that contested and reached five in their first seven games with the win.
