**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** The Retrievers were unable to start a winning streak falling to Vermont last Wednesday night at UMBC RAC Arena by a final of 69-51. UMBC was going for back-to-back win for the first time since defeating Lafayette and American in back-to-back games in early December. With three games left in the regular season UMBC is three games back of ninth place in the America East Standings. For the game Matea Pender tallied her fourth double-double of the year with 14 points and 11 rebounds as UMBC trailed by one, 41-40 with 8:29 to play in the second half but an 11-0 run by the Catamounts and 10-of-10 free throw shooting in the final two minutes allowed Vermont to secure the win. Brittanie Hughes finished with a team-high 15 points and Sharri Rohde and Heather Luttrell scored 10 each. The game marked the fourth time this year four players for UMBC have hit double digits in a single game. Rohde and Hughes each have four-game double digit scoring streaks.

**HAWKS UPDATE:** Hartford dropped their third game in the last four outings with two of the three losses on the road. The Hawks are on a two-game slide and scored a conference season-low 37 against Binghamton last time out. Ikea Witt leads Hartford with 11.9 ppg and Erika Messam is averaging 11.7 ppg. Hartford ranks second in the conference with a 10-5 league mark.

**Who's Up Next:** The Retrievers hit the road for the final two games of the regular season. UMBC travels to New Hampshire on Mar. 3 at 7 p.m. and heads to Maine on Mar. 5 at 7:30 p.m.

## QUICK HITS:

### Against Hartford

\* UMBC's trails Hartford in the all-time series 3-1 with their only win in the lone meeting at UMBC RAC Arena as the Retrievers came away with a 48-46 win last year. Hartford won the first meeting at the St. Joseph's tournament and both meetings on their home court.

### Match-up Notes

\* The Retrievers versus Hartford match-up focuses on defense as Hartford and UMBC rank one and two, respectively, in the America East Conference standings for scoring defense. Hartford leads the league allowing 55.0 ppg while UMBC has held opponents to an average of 57.9 ppg.

### Last Meeting

\* UMBC suffered the effects of a tough first half as Hartford behind 51.6 percent shooting in the opening stanza took at 38-13 lead. UMBC composed themselves in the second half outscoring Hartford 26-18 but were unable to overcome the first half deficit as Hartford captured the 56-39 victory. Sharri Rohde led UMBC with 14 points playing all 40 minutes while Ikea Witt and Danielle Hood finished with 14 points and 11 points respectively.

### UMBC Takes On Top-Four In Conference Down The Stretch

\* The way the league is panning out this year UMBC has drawn the short straw heading into the final four games of the season of playing the top-four teams in the conference standings, almost in exact ascending order. UMBC's last opponent Vermont (fourth in conference standings) defeated UMBC 69-51 at UMBC RAC Arena on Feb. 23. UMBC hosts Hartford (second), before traveling to New Hampshire (third) and Maine (first) to end the season. Facing the top teams in the league to end the season will challenge UMBC has all-10 teams make the league tournament with the bottom four playing on opening night to play-in to the quarterfinal round.

### Rohde Leads League In Free Throw Percentage In Conference Play

\* Sophomore Sharri Rohde leads the league in free throw percentage in conference play, having hit 34-of-37 attempts from the charity stripe over the league's first 15 games. Rohde had only missed on free throw in conference play before a 2-for-4 night at the free throw line against Vermont in UMBC's last outing. Rohde is an impressive 91.9 percent from the free

throw line, including a career-high 8-of-8 free throws in the second meeting against Binghamton this season.

### Rohde Emerging As Defensive Specialist

\* Sophomore Sharri Rohde, who normally garners the task of guarding the opponent's top player, has emerged as a defensive force. Rohde currently ranks in overall America East statistics in 6th place in steals at 1.79 spg and 5th in block shots at 1.00 bpg. In America East Conference games Rohde is second in steals at 1.87 spg and ranks 7th in blocks at 1.00 bpg.

### Pender Ranks Second In Nation Three-Point Field Goal Percentage Chart

\* Matea Pender in the latest NCAA statistics which run thru games as of Feb. 20, 2005, moved back up to second after falling to third last week in three-point percentage. Pender led the nation in three-point field goal percentage for five straight weeks and enters this week shooting 52.3 percent from the field at 58-of-111. Pender went 2-of-10 in UMBC's last outing from outside the arc and dropped below 50.0 percent (49.6 percent) for the first time this season.

### Getting Ahead

\* UMBC has had trouble after falling behind this year showing their need to get ahead early on. UMBC when trailing at halftime is 1-11 this year and are 0-11 when trailing with 10 minutes left in the game. The Retrievers are 7-3 when leading with five minutes left in the game and 6-4 when leading at halftime, showing the ability to sustain leads once ahead.

### Pender's lead

\* In UMBC's eight wins this season Matea Pender is averaging 19.0 ppg, shooting 52.9 percent from the field (55-of-99) and 65.9 percent from three-point range (29-of-44). In four of those eight games Pender has scored 20 or more points. In games lost Pender is averaging 12.4 ppg.

### 40 Minute Nights

\* In 11 of UMBC's 15 conference games at least one player has played 40 minutes. Sharri Rohde and Matea Pender lead UMBC with five 40-minute nights on the season while Hughes has logged all the minutes on four occasions this season.

### Drabyn Out For Season

\* Freshman Kristin Drabyn suffered a broken finger and has been sidelined the rest of the 2004-05 season. She joins Tyecia Powell (ACL) and Zuzana Kasanová (ACL) on UMBC's injured list.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his third season with the Retrievers and ninth season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year

with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

UMBC this year. Pender at Stony Brook, scored a career-high 30 points against the Seawolves on 7-of-15 shooting from the field and 6-of-8 shooting from three-point range. Pender's 30-points rank tied for 12th on UMBC's all-time single-game points scored chart. Goncharova against New Hampshire topped Pender's performance with 33 points on 12-of-13 shooting from the field and 9-of-10 from three-point range. The last time a UMBC player prior to this season hit 30-points in a game was Shalayna Johnson on March 1, 2003 when she set the school record with 37 against Quinnipiac.

**Pender Named America East Co-Player of the Week For Second Time This Season...**

UMBC junior **Matea Pender** was named America East Co-Player of the Week for the week ending Dec. 12, 2004. Pender had a stellar week for the Retrievers dropping double-digits in three-consecutive games to up her streak to six-straight double-digit performances and scored her third and fourth 20-plus point performances of the year. Pender on the week shot 58.3 percent from the floor (21-of-36) and an outstanding 72.2 percent from three-point range (13-of-18). Against Lafayette she tallied a career-high six made three-point baskets (6-of-8), netting 22-points, and followed that up going 5-of-6 from behind the arc two nights later against American as she led UMBC with 25-points.

**Retrievers Go With Pender...**

UMBC is following the lead of junior **Matea Pender** as the Retrievers are 8-9 in games Pender has scored double-digits. In UMBC wins, Pender is averaging 19.0 ppg, shooting 52.9 percent from the field (55-of-99) and 65.9 percent from three-point range (29-of-44). UMBC's 13 three-point baskets against New Hampshire was one trey off their school record of 14 set by the Retrievers last year at Northeastern. UMBC has hit double-digits in three-point field goals made on five occasions this season.

UMBC as a team recorded 20 assists or more in six games this season, eclipsing their total amount of assists in any one game all of last year with 21 in each of the first two.
