**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** UMBC is off to a 2-0 start for the first time since the 2002-03 season, head coach Phil Stern's first year at the helm of the Retriever program. UMBC is coming off a 76-58 win over Fairleigh Dickinson in the finale of the Retriever Tip-Off Tournament as the Retrievers won their home tournament. Senior Matea Pender tallied 16 points against FDU and was named tournament most valuable player after back-to-back double-digit performances and a 14.5 ppg average over the two games. Brittanie Hughes led the Retriever offense that dished out 24 assists in game one and 26 assists in game two of the tournament. Hughes tallied eight assists for a career high. Amanda Robinson tallied her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds in the tournament title game.

**BULLS' UPDATE:** The University of South Florida Bulls moved to 3-0 on the year with a 98-60 win over Jacksonville on Wednesday night. USF (3-0) put six players in double figures led by Nalini Miller and Jessica Dickson, who tallied 21 and 20 points respectively. Dickson had her second straight 20-point game and the 25th of her career. She scored 23 points against Tennessee-Martin on Nov. 20. Dickson was also in double figures for the 18th straight game dating back to last year.

**Who's Up Next:** UMBC will play either in the consolation or championship game of the Best Western Roundball Classic against Robert Morris or Loyola (Ill.) on Sunday.

**Head Coach Phil Stern**  
**Concordia College, '94**  
**Career: 122-132 (.480) (10th Season)**  
**UMBC: 28-60 (.318) (4th Season)**

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his fourth season with the Retrievers and 10th season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

# Retriever Quick Shots ...

- UMBC has used a very deep bench the first two games of the season with 11 players seeing significant minutes and all 13 available players seeing action in each game on the season. UMBC in two games is averaging 26.5 bench points per game. Sophomore guard **Kristin Drabyn** leads UMBC off the bench with 7.5 ppg.
- UMBC tallied 24 assists against Morgan State and 26 against Fairleigh Dickinson as the Retrievers have twice surpassed last season's single-game mark of 23 assists against Lafayette. UMBC last season led the America East Conference in assists at 15.0 per game. The Retrievers' single-game mark for assists is 27, set in 1985 against Shippensburg.
- **Brittanie Hughes** dished out a career-high eight assists against Fairleigh Dickinson and is averaging 6.0 apg through the first two games of the season. The junior point guard led UMBC with 99 assists on the year last season and ranked among the conference leaders in the category.
- **Amanda Robinson's** six blocks against Morgan State tied Eunice French for the most blocks recorded in a single game by a Retriever. Robinson had three blocks in the first five minutes against Morgan State.
- UMBC as a team blocked nine shots against Morgan State, with **Amanda Robinson** recording six, **Nicole Dixon** recording two and **Mackenzie Butler** one. UMBC on the season is averaging 5.5 bpg
- UMBC has not had one player play over 30 minutes to date this season. In 14 out of the final 18 games last season, at least one player on the Retriever squad played all-40 minutes. **Sharri Rohde** leads UMBC with 11 40-minute nights in her career while **Brittanie Hughes** has logged all the minutes on the court on seven occasions.
- Senior **Matea Pender** was named Retriever Tip-Off Tournament Most Valuable Player after averaging 14.5 ppg in the two games. Pender shot .500 from outside the arc, making 5-for-10 while shooting 47.6 percent from the field on 10-of-21. Pender added 10 rebounds, four assists and two steals in the two-day event.
- **Amanda Robinson** recorded her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds against Fairleigh Dickinson. Dating back to last season, Robinson has double-digit scoring in four of her last five games.
- **Brittanie Hughes** has a streak of three consecutive games with double-digit scoring dating back to last season's finale. Hughes scored 15 points in the America East Tournament in the Retrievers' final game of the season. In two games this year, Hughes has scored 11 points against Morgan State and 13 points against Fairleigh Dickinson. Hughes earned a spot on the Retriever Tip-Off Tournament All-Tournament team for the second consecutive season after her performance over the weekend.
- UMBC has been very efficient from the field to date this season with the Retrievers shooting 45.0 percent. In the second half against Fairleigh Dickinson, UMBC shot 56.7 percent from the field on 17-of-30, including a spurt within a 2:30 minute span that point guard **Brittanie Hughes** hit four consecutive baskets and scored 11 points on three three-pointers and a two-pointer. UMBC against Morgan State shot 42.4 percent from the field and shot 47.6 percent against FDU.
- Junior **Sharri Rohde** extended her streak to 58 consecutive starts and has not missed a start in her entire collegiate career, starting all 28 games as a freshman and sophomore and every one this year.

## News and Notes...

**UMBC Captures Tip-Off Tournament Title...**UMBC for the first time in the three-year history of the Retriever Tip-Off Tournament captured the title, defeating Morgan State, 72-50, in the opening round to advance the championship game against Fairleigh Dickinson. UMBC went on to beat FDU, 76-58, to win the title as Matea Pender earned tournament most valuable player honors and Brittne Hughes made the all-tournament team.

**UMBC Opens At 2-0...**UMBC opened the season with back-to-back wins for the first time since the 2002-03 season, head coach Phil Stern's first year with the Retrievers. The last time UMBC opened a season at 3-0 was 1989-90, where the Retrievers won The Big Four Classic hosted by UMBC with wins over Coppin State and Loyola before defeating Liberty.
