**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** UMBC is off to a 3-1 record for the second consecutive season after posting a 1-1 mark at the South Florida Tournament last weekend. Junior point guard Brittnie Hughes earned a spot on the All-Tournament team after scoring 15.5 ppg and handing out 4.5 apg in the two-game event. Hughes on the season is tied with Matea Pender for the team lead in points per game at 13.8. Hughes and Pender lead the America East Conference with consecutive double-digit performances. Hughes has five dating back to last season and Pender with double-digits in all four games this season. The Retrievers as a team have three players averaging double-figures as Amanda Robinson is averaging 10.3 ppg on the year.

**EAGLES' UPDATE:** American University earned its first win of the season with a 76-74 overtime win over Western Michigan in the Florida International Tournament last weekend. Tala Hadavi leads three Eagles in double-digit scoring on the season with 13.0 ppg. Abby Lipkis is averaging 10.5 ppg and 8.3 rpg on the year while Tara Williams is averaging 10.3 ppg.

**Who's Up Next:** UMBC returns home to host Longwood at 7 p.m. on Saturday night at UMBC RAC Arena. The game will mark the first time UMBC has met Longwood since the 1990 season.

# Retriever Gameday ...

**Game Notes:** UMBC against American is the Retrievers' fifth game of the season as UMBC is out to a 3-1 start for the second consecutive season. UMBC is looking to go 4-1 for the first time since 1989-90 when the Retrievers opened 3-0 and became a 4-1 team on Dec. 4 with a win over Rider. The Retrievers travel to American for the first time since the 2002-03 season, having played the last two games at UMBC. The Retrievers are 1-3 against the Eagles at American's home court. Last season UMBC defeated American by a final of 67-49 as Matea Pender scored 25 points against the Eagles. That win propelled UMBC to five wins the fastest in the Retrievers' D-I history.

# Retriever Quick Shots ...

- **Brittanie Hughes** has the longest streak of double-digit performances entering the week with five-straight games dating back to last season with double-digit scoring. Hughes scored 15 points in the America East Tournament in the Retrievers' final game of the season last year. This year Hughes has tallied 10-plus points in all four games and earned spots on the All-Tournament teams the last two weekends. **Matea Pender** has the second longest streak at four games, on in each this season. **Amanda Robinson** has six double-digit games in her last seven dating back to last season.

- UMBC has used a very deep bench the first four games of the season with 11 players seeing significant minutes and all 13 available players seeing action in each game on the season. UMBC in four games is averaging 17.0 bench points per game. Sophomore guard **Kristin Drabyn** leads UMBC off the bench with 4.3 ppg. The Retrievers balanced attack has kept players fresh as no player is averaging 30 minutes per game. In 14 out of the final 18 games last season, at least one player on the Retriever squad played all-40 minutes. **Sharri Rohde** leads UMBC with 11 40-minute nights in her career while **Brittanie Hughes** has logged all the minutes on the court on seven occasions.

- UMBC has been very efficient from the field to date this season with the Retrievers shooting 43.4 percent. UMBC has yet to shoot under 40.0 percent in a game this season.

- In all three of UMBC's wins Matea Pender has led or tied for the team lead in scoring. Pender in UMBC wins this season is averaging 15.0 ppg and shooting 46.9 percent from the field and 53.3 percent from three-point range.

- In the last two games UMBC has place four players in double digits in each game.

- Junior **Sharri Rohde** extended her streak to 60 consecutive starts and has not missed a start in her entire collegiate career, starting all 28 games as a freshman and sophomore and every one this year.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his fourth season with the Retrievers and 10th season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

**News and Notes...**

**UMBC Places Third At South Florida Tournament...**UMBC drew the short straw of facing BIG EAST opponent and host school South Florida in the opening round of the Best Western Round Ball Classic. Despite being tied 53-53 with five minutes remaining the Retrievers came up short and moved to the consolation game against Loyola (Ill.). UMBC returned to the winning track with a 67-55 win over Loyola (Ill.) behind Brittanie Hughes and Matea Pender's 16 points each.

**Hughes Named To Second All-Tournament Team...**When it comes to tournaments, UMBC junior point guard Brittanie Hughes has stepped up to the challenge, earning a spot on both all-tournament teams this season. Hughes won a spot on the Retriever Tip-Off Tournament team after leading the Retrievers to the title. At South Florida, Hughes averaged 15.5 ppg and 4.25 apg to lead the Retrievers to a 1-1 mark. Last year Hughes was named to the 2004 Retriever Tip-Off Tournament team.

**Lending a helping hand...**UMBC lead the America East Conference for the second consecutive season in assists per game. The Retrievers to date have recorded 20.00 apg. UMBC has two games with 20-plus assists this season, including 26 against Fairleigh Dickinson as the Retrievers came one assist away from their single-season mark of 27, set in 1985 against Shippensburg. **Brittanie Hughes** dished out a career-high eight assists against Fairleigh Dickinson and is averaging 5.25 apg through four games of the season. The junior point guard led UMBC with 99 assists on the year last season and ranked among the conference leaders in the category.

**Block Party...**Amanda Robinson's six blocks against Morgan State tied Eunice French for the most blocks recorded in a single game by a Retriever. Robinson had three blocks in the
