RETRIEVER UPDATE: UMBC is currently on a five game win streak, its longest since winning five in a row during the 1995-96 as the Retrievers have earned the most conference wins since joining the league two years ago. UMBC's latest win came against Boston U., as the Retrievers knocked off the second placed ranked team for the third time in the last four games with a 63-57 win over the Terriers. UMBC took the lead in the first stanza and built a nine point margin into the break. The Retrievers never trailed in the second half, answering all the Terrier runs to reach the six point victory. Sharri Rohde tallied 23 points for a career high to lead all scorers while Matea Pender scored 17 points and Brittnie Hughes 10. Rohde led UMBC on the boards with seven rebounds and dished out a team-high four assists. Pender leads UMBC at 13.4 ppg while Rohde ranks second on the team at 11.9 ppg.

CATAMOUNT UPDATE: Vermont has spun into a five-game slide after opening the league with a 3-2 record. The Catamounts are coming off an 81-74 loss to Stony Brook in which the Catamounts were winning the majority of the second half and was tied at 73-73 with 2:10 left in the game. Britney Cross led the way for Vermont scoring 15 points in the game as four Catamounts hit double figures. Vermont is led by America East leading scorer Alexis Castro at 16.3 ppg

Retriever Gameday ...

Game Notes: UMBC against Vermont is the Retrievers' 22nd game of the season, 11th in the America East Conference and ninth home game. The game marks the sixth all-time meeting between the two programs with Vermont holding a 4-1 all-time advantage. Vermont has won the last four meetings against UMBC, including the meeting earlier this year in which the Catamounts won 72-60. The Catamounts jumped out on UMBC early with a 26-10 run to open the game. UMBC closed the gap to 35-27 but would get no closer as UVM scored the final five points of the first half and the first five to open the second half. UMBC was led by 11 points from Sharri Rohde. Alexis Castro paced the Catamounts with 19 points. Entering today's game, UMBC and Vermont are on different paths with UMBC winning five straight and the Catamounts looking to stop a five game slide. Castro for Vermont is the league's leader in scoring at 16.3 ppg while will UMBC counter with the top field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to 36.8 percent shooting.

Retriever Quick Shots ...

- **Swarming Defense...**UMBC's defense has been swarming the past five games, holding opponents to 47.1 ppg and 31.5 percent shooting during that span. During the last five, the Retriever defense has held two of the top offensive teams in the league to season lows in field goal percentage and points per game. Against Binghamton, who entered the game leading the league in points per game and field goal percentage, the Bearcats were held to season lows of 29.2 percent shooting from the field and scoring 37 points. Binghamton's previous season low was 53 points in the opener against Kansas. UMBC held Stony Brook to 48 points, the first time this season they did not score out of the 40's as they shot a season low 28.6 percent. UMBC's defense has 19 blocks (3.8 bpg) and 38 steals (7.6 spg) in the last five games.

- **UMBC Offense Complementing The Defense...**UMBC's offense has been complementing its defense lately, scoring over 60 points in the last four games and averaging 61.8 ppg and a 44.4 shooting percentage over the last five. During that span UMBC has a positive 14.6 ppg scoring margin over opponents.

- **Retrievers Ranking High In Conference Categories...**UMBC is ranking high on a number of conference categories including leading the league in assists per game at 17.1 and field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to 36.8 percent shooting. UMBC ranks second in scoring defense (58.0 ppg), scoring margin (+5.6 ppg), field goal percentage (43.7 percent), and three-point field goal percentage (35.3 percent).

- **Rohde and Hughes Heating Up...**UMBC's junior duo of Sharri Rohde and Brittanie Hughes have heated up lately as Rohde is averaging 18.0 ppg, 8.6 rpg, 3.6 apg over the last five games while Hughes is averaging 12.6 ppg during that same span. Rohde is shooting 63.5 percent from the floor over the last five games with three 20-plus point games. Rohde has gone 33-for-52 from the field. Hughes is currently on a four-game double digit scoring streak. Rohde set a new career high with 23 points against Boston U.

- **UMBC Among Nations Top Assisters...**UMBC in the last released NCAA statistics as of games through Jan. 30, 2006, ranked 12th in the nation with 17.3 apg. The NCAA Statistics are released every Tuesday afternoon.

- **No Place Like Home...**UMBC has a 7-1 home record this season with four of the final six regular season games at RAC Arena. UMBC moved past its toughest schedule after playing five for the first seven league games on the road. UMBC's best home record was a 10-0 mark during the 1993-94 season.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his fourth season with the Retrievers and 10th season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

News and Notes...

Stern Continues Growth of Retrievers' Program...Head coach **Phil Stern** continues to build the UMBC women's basketball program towards the top of the America East Conference, having made progressive steps forward each year. UMBC with 13 wins has surpassed its win total from the previous year for the second consecutive season. Below are current notes on UMBC's growth this season.

- UMBC's 13 wins are five more than its 2004-05 record of eight victories (UMBC recorded four wins in 2003-04).

- UMBC is on a five-game win streak, the longest since joining the America East Conference.

- The last time UMBC went on a five-game win streak was during the 1995-96 season. UMBC set a school record with 10 consecutive wins during the 1993-94 season.

- UMBC's 13 wins are the most since Stern's first year, where he directed UMBC to a 14-16 mark. Stern only had 12 regular season wins that year, winning two games to make it to the conference title game in the league tournament.

- UMBC the last two years recorded its best start since joining Division-I, this year opening the year 6-1.

- UMBC's five conference wins is the Retrievers' most wins in the league, topping the four-win mark set in 2003-04.

- UMBC is 7-1 at home, the best mark since going 10-0 in 1993-94.

- UMBC's current success is coming as the America East Conference is ranked 11th in the RPI poll and third among I-AA conferences.

America East Conference Ranked 11th in RPI Poll...America East has moved up one spot to 11th in The Collegiate Basketball News Women's RPI Report and now ranks third among I-AA conferences. Only the Colonial (eighth) and Atlantic 10 (10th) are higher ranking I-AA leagues. America East has never finished as high as 11th in the final RPI for a season and never as high as third among I-AA Conferences. America East boasts three teams with RPIs in the top 100. Stony Brook leads the conference with an RPI of 36, followed by Hartford (40) and Boston University (78). UMBC holds an RPI ranking of 175.

Sharri Rohde Named America East Wilson Player of the Week (1-30-06)...UMBC junior Sharri Rohde tallied back-to-back 20-point performances and averaged a double-double in two games against Albany and Stony Brook, leading to her first America East weekly conference honor. Rohde averaged a double-double with 20.0 ppg and 10.0 rpg. She shot 66.7 percent from the field making 16-of-24 field goals. Rohde dished out six helpers as well while blocking a shot and recording three steals.

Lending a helping hand...UMBC leads the America East Conference for the second consecutive season in assists per game and ranks 12th in the NCAA Statistics through games Feb. 6, 2006. The Retrievers to date have recorded 17.1 apg.
