**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** UMBC came off its bye weekend to defeat Maine 60-47 at home last Wednesday night, moving the Retrievers record to 7-1 over the last eight games. UMBC trailed the majority of the game, being held to a season-low 13 points in the first half as the Retrievers shot 20.0 percent from the field. The Retrievers, however, found their touch in the second stanza, scoring a season-high 47 points in the second half. The Retrievers shot 62.5 percent from the floor in the second period as they erased Maine's 13-point lead in the final 14 minutes for the win. Sharri Rohde was held scoreless until the 11:27 mark as she scored a lay-up off an offensive rebound, sparking nine straight points from the junior forward. Rohde scored 15 points in the remaining 11 plus minutes to lead UMBC. Matea Pender tallied 12 points and leads the Retrievers at 13.0 ppg. Rohde averaged 12.3 ppg followed by Brittnie Hughes at 11.1 ppg.

**BEARCAT UPDATE:** Binghamton had its bye this past week and is currently on a four-game slide, falling to Hartford, 66-56, their last time out. Jen Haubrich led the Bearcats with 12 points while Juta Jahilo came off the bench to score 10 points. Laine Kurpniece leads Binghamton with 12.3 ppg followed by Jen Blues at 10.6 ppg and Rachel Laws with 10.8 ppg. Binghamton currently holds a 6-7 league mark, one game behind UMBC.

**Who's Up Next:** UMBC returns home for Senior Night on Tuesday, February 28 against Stony Brook at 7 p.m. in RAC Arena.

# Retriever Gameday ...

**Game Notes:** UMBC against Binghamton is the Retrievers' 25th game of the season, 14th in the America East Conference and 13th road game. The game marks the sixth all-time meeting between the two programs with Binghamton holding a 3-2 all-time advantage. Earlier this year UMBC defeated Binghamton 63-37, holding the Bearcats to a season-low in points scored at 37 and in field goal percentage at 29.2 despite the Bearcats coming into the game leading the America East Conference in both categories. Amanda Robinson scored a game-high 16 points while Brittanie Hughes tallied 14 points for UMBC. Laura Sario led Binghamton with 14 points. Binghamton and UMBC currently rank as the top-two shooting teams in the conference as the Bearcats are shooting a league best 43.7 percent from the field while UMBC is shooting 43.5 percent. UMBC is more stringent defensively, holding opponents to a league best 36.9 percent shooting while Binghamton's field goal percentage defense ranks sixth at 40.7 percent.

# Retriever Quick Shots ...

● **Retrievers 7-1 Over Last Eight Games...**UMBC returned to the winning trail with a win over Maine for its seventh win in the last eight games. UMBC was on a six game win streak, which was tied for the 20th best active mark in the country according to ncaasports.com on February 14, prior to meeting Hartford that night. The Hawks, who entered the game receiving votes in the AP Top-25 poll, defeated UMBC 56-49 in overtime.

● **Swarming Defense...**UMBC's defense has been swarming as of late, holding opponents to 50.2 ppg and 33.8 percent shooting during last eight games. The Retriever defense has held two of the top offensive teams in the league to season lows in field goal percentage and points per game. In addition, UMBC held Hartford to its lowest second half output in points at 12 and field goals percentage at 15.4 percent en route to holding the Hawks to a season low of 43 points for 40 minutes. The UMBC defense ranks first in field goal percentage defense, second in scoring defense and third in rebounding defense.

● **Rohde Keeping The Retrievers Rolling...**UMBC's junior Sharri Rohde is averaging 17.5 ppg, 8.0 rpg and shooting 60.7 percent from the floor during the Retrievers' last eight games in which UMBC has went 7-1. Rohde was held scoreless until the 11:27 mark in the second half against Maine as the Retrievers trailed by 10 points when Rohde hit her first basket of the game. Rohde scored nine-straight points and 15 in the final 11 plus minutes as UMBC turned around for a 13-point win. Rohde has earned two conference weekly honors during league play and tallied 20-plus points in three occasions. The Retriever forward has scored double figures in 11-of-13 conference games and ranks in the top-10 in four conference categories.

● **UMBC Among Nations Best Improved Teams...**UMBC is one of the nations most improved teams ranking tied for eighth with seven more wins than last year.

● **UMBC Among Nations Top Assisters...**UMBC in the last released NCAA statistics as of games through Feb. 20, 2006, ranked 19th in the nation with 16.8 apg. The NCAA Statistics are released every Tuesday afternoon.

● **No Place Like Home...**UMBC has a 9-2 home record this season with the Retrievers final home game and Senior Night on Tuesday, Feb. 28 at 7 p.m. UMBC's best home record was a 10-0 mark during the 1993-94 season.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his fourth season with the Retrievers and 10th season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Amongst the many accolades in Stern's file are the WBCA District III Coach of the Year and the Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year award he received after taking a 5-22 squad three years later to the NCAA Division II Tournament. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year with the Retrievers, who missed the conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to a game away from the NCAA Division I Tournament as they reached the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference.

*Retriever Up Rising*

Head coach **Phil Stern** continues to build the UMBC women's basketball program towards the top of the America East Conference, having made progressive steps forward each year. UMBC with 15 wins has surpassed its win total from the previous year for the second consecutive season. Below are current notes on UMBC's growth this season.

- UMBC's 15 wins are seven more than its 2004-05 record of eight victories (UMBC recorded four wins in 2003-04).
- UMBC's seven additional wins this season ranks UMBC as the eighth best improved team in the nation (see chart on page 3)
- UMBC's 15 wins secures UMBC with its first .500 season since going 15-13 in 1993-94.
- UMBC's 15 wins is the most regular season wins since winning 17 regular season games during the 1990-91 season.

- UMBC's 15 wins is tied for the second most wins since the Retrievers turned Division-I in 1986-87. UMBC's top seasons came in 1990-91 (17 wins), 1986-87 (15 wins), 1993-94 (15 wins).

- UMBC's six-game win streak (ended Feb. 14, 2006), was the longest since joining the America East Conference.

- The last time UMBC went on a six-game win streak was during the 1993-94 season in which UMBC set a school record with 10 consecutive wins.

- UMBC the last two years recorded its best start since joining Division-I, this year opening the year 6-1.

- UMBC's seven conference wins is the Retrievers' most wins in the league, topping the four-win mark set in 2003-04.

- UMBC is 9-2 at home, the best mark since going 10-0 in 1993-94.

- UMBC's current success is coming as the America East Conference is ranked 11th in the RPI poll and third among I-AA conferences.

**News and Notes...**

**America East Conference Ranked 11th in RPI Poll...**America East has maintained its 11th ranking in The Collegiate Basketball News Women's RPI Report and ranks third among I-AA conferences. Only the Colonial (eighth) and Atlantic 10 (10th) are higher ranking I-AA leagues. America East has never finished as high as 11th in the final RPI for a season and never as high as third among I-AA Conferences. America East boasts three teams with RPIs in the top 100. Hartford leads the conference with an RPI of 33, followed by Stony Brook (38) and Boston University (73). UMBC has the fifth highest RPI in the league at 156.

**Pender, Rohde, Hughes Reaching New Career Scoring Milestones...**Matea Pender, Sharri Rohde and Brittanie Hughes continue to reach new career milestones in the scoring category. Pender recent-

ly passed the 900-point barrier and is closing in on 1,000 career points. Pender ranks 15th all-time on UMBC's career scoring chart. Rohde blew by the 700-point plateau with 19 against Hartford while Hughes has past the 500-point mark.

**Relentless Retrievers...**UMBC has come-from-behind in 12 of its 15 wins this season, including three wins after trailing by 10 or more points. The Retrievers overcame a 10 point deficit by Albany, a 16 point deficit by Vermont and a 13 point deficit by Maine in conference games. UMBC also fought back from 13 down against Hartford to send the game to overtime.
