RETRIEVER UPDATE: UMBC snapped its two-game losing skid with a 60-50 victory over America East rival Binghamton Saturday evening. The Retrievers have won five of their last seven games and at 2-2 in conference play are off to their best since joining the league in 2003-04. With nine wins overall this season, UMBC has amassed its second-highest victory total since joining the America East. Junior forward **Amanda Robinson** has averaged 17.5 ppg in four league contests, and she is shooting 48.3 percent in those games. Senior forward **Sharri Rohde** has scored in double figures in each of her last nine games. UMBC is the only team in the America East with four players ranking among the league's top 15 in scoring.

HAWK UPDATE: The defending America East champion Hartford Hawks are 9-7 overall and 2-1 in league action after suffering its first America East Conference loss of the season in overtime Wednesday night to Vermont. Danielle Hood scored a season-high 22 points in the game and leads the Hawks with 11.3 ppg, ranking 11th in the conference. Teammate Ikea Witt is close behind, ranking 12th with 11.0 ppg. Hartford leads the league in scoring defense, allowing just 54.8 ppg, and opponents are shooting just 36.2 percent, best in the conference.

Who's Up Next: The Retrievers conclude their two-game road trip at New Hampshire on Saturday, Jan. 20.

Head Women's Basketball Coach Phil Stern is in his fifth season with the Retrievers and 11th season as a collegiate head women's basketball coach. Among the many accolades in Stern's file are the 2001-02 WBCA District III Coach of the Year and Peach Belt Conference Coach of the Year, which he received after taking a USC Aiken squad that finished 5-22 in 1999 to the NCAA Division II Tournament three years later. Stern almost had the same success with UMBC. In his first year with the Retrievers, who missed the Northeast Conference tournament the prior year, Stern took UMBC to the NEC title game. Stern is looking to continue the revitalization of the Retrievers as they continue to grow in the mid-major America East Conference. In 2005-06, he led UMBC to its first winning season since 1993-94 with a 15-13 record, turning around a team that finished 8-20 the year before.

INSIDE THE SERIES...

Tonight's game marks the eighth all-time meeting between UMBC and Hartford, and the Hawks hold a 6-1 series advantage. The first meeting occurred on Dec. 29, 2002, a 60-47 victory for Hartford. The Hawks took the first two games in the series before UMBC won, 48-46, on Feb. 28, 2004, at the RAC Arena, but Hartford has taken the last four matchups. As conference rivals, the teams have met twice a year since UMBC joined the league in 2004, and the Retrievers have never won at Chase Arena.

In the last meeting, Feb. 15, 2006, the Hawks came away with a 56-49 overtime victory at RAC Arena, snapping the Retrievers' six-game winning streak, but extending Hartford's streak to 14 in a row. UMBC forward **Sharri Rohde** led all scorers with 19 points. The Retrievers fell behind by as many as 13 in the first half, but opened the second period on a 16-3 run to take a two-point lead. The Hawks made just four field goals and 12 points in the second half. Danielle Hood led Hartford with 16 points.

News and Notes...

For Starters: The Retrievers snapped a brief two-game losing skid and have won five of their last seven games. UMBC is 9-8 for the second year in a row, and at 2-2 in conference play, the Retrievers are off to their best league start since joining the America East in 2003-04.

Rohde Passes 1,000: With 10 points against Stony Brook, senior forward **Sharri Rohde** became the 15th player in UMBC history to score 1,000 points in her career. She currently ranks 15th all-time with 1,031 points. Next on her list is Monica Logan ('99) with 1,036.

five of the last seven, while junior forward **Amanda Robinson** has a four-game double-figure scoring streak.

America East Opener: The Retrievers' 66-58 victory over Boston University in its America East opener marked the first time UMBC has won its America East opener since joining the league in 2003-04 and also marked the Retrievers' first victory in their first conference game of the season since 1997-98 when members of the Big South.

Coaching Milestones: Saturday's victory over Binghamton was head coach **Phil Stern's** 50th at UMBC and the 144th of his career. He is just six shy of reaching the 150-victory milestone.

Lending a Helping Hand: The Retrievers rank third in the America East and 85th in the NCAA with 14.59 assists per game, and senior point guard **Brittanie Hughes** leads the league and ranks 60th in the nation with 4.65 apg. UMBC dished out a season-high 26 assists on Dec. 2 at Fairleigh Dickinson, just one shy of the school record of 27 set against Shippensburg on Dec. 2, 1985. Hughes (7) and senior forward **Sharri Rohde** (8) combined for 15 of the team's 26 assists in the game.

Helping Hand, Part II: Senior point guard **Brittanie Hughes** and senior forward **Sharri Rohde** are UMBC's active career leaders in assists with 298 and 287, respectively. Hughes is tied for seventh all-time, while Rohde ranks ninth. Rohde entered the season with 22 more dishes in her career than Hughes, but the point guard has averaged 4.65 helpers per game this season, with a career-best 12 on Dec. 29 against Texas State to gain the lead.

Big D: One of the stingiest defenses in the America East conference, UMBC ranks second in the league and 58th in the NCAA in field goal percentage defense (.369) and ranks third the conference and 80th in the nation in scoring defense (59.4 ppg). The Retrievers have held opponents below 20 points in a half five times this season - Dec. 29 against Texas State (15/1st), Dec. 9 at Longwood (16/1st), Nov. 21 vs. Towson (17/1st), Dec. 28 against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (18/1st) and Jan. 13 against Binghamton (18/1st). Similarly, UMBC has held opponents below 20 percent shooting in a period in four games - Nov. 26 vs. NJIT (16.7 percent/2nd), Dec. 28 vs. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (17.9 percent/1st), Dec. 29 vs. Texas State (18.2 percent/1st) and Dec. 9 at Longwood (18.5 percent/1st).

Three's Company: Junior guard **Kristin Drabyn** leads the America East and ranks 91st in the nation with 2.12 three-pointers made per game. Drabyn drilled nine of 18 triples in two games at the Battle at the Border Tournament, including a career-high six against Texas State on Dec. 29. It was the most three-pointers made by a Retrievers since Ana Goncharova connected on nine on Jan. 29, 2005 against Stony Brook. As a team, UMBC ranks third in the America East and 53rd in the NCAA in three-pointers made per game (5.65). Senior point guard **Brittanie Hughes** is shooting 41.4 percent from long distance, third-best in the conference, and ranks 10th with 1.41 treys per game, including a career-high four against Stony Brook.

Block Party: Junior forward **Amanda Robinson** blocked a season-high five shots - one off her career high - on Dec. 29 against Texas State. She ranks third in the conference with 1.29 bpg and has blocked 12 shots in her last five games. Senior forward **Sharri Rohde**, UMBC's active blocks leader, ranks fifth all-time with 79 career blocks, while Robinson moved into eighth place all-time with 71 after recording three against Binghamton.
