**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** UMBC snapped its two-game losing streak with Friday's 67-64 upset victory over second-seeded Stony Brook, UMBC's first-ever America East Tournament win and its first defeat of Stony Brook since Jan. 29, 2006. Senior point guard **Brittanie Hughes** scored 21 points and tied a career high with seven rebounds, while senior forward **Sharri Rohde** scored 17 points and junior forward **Amanda Robinson** had 15. After dropping the first two games of the season, the Retrievers alternated wins and losses for a month before a 69-61 win at Rider sparked a four-game winning streak. UMBC defeated Boston University on Jan. 4, the first time the Retrievers have ever won their America East opener, but dropped seven of their next nine games, including four straight from Jan. 24-Feb. 7. But a 66-41 win over Albany at home led the Retrievers to winning three out of four games and put them right back in a crowded middle of the pack in the America East standings before they dropped their last two games of the season to finish seventh in the conference. The No. 7 seed is UMBC's second-highest seed in the America East after taking the fifth slot last season. The Retrievers were the 10th seed in their first two America East Tournaments. UMBC swept the season series from just one conference opponent - New Hampshire - and was swept by Hartford, Stony Brook and Maine in the regular season. After averaging 76 points in the two previous games - nearly 16 points more than their season average - the Retrievers were held to just 56 points in a 60-56 loss to Hartford in the regular season finale. UMBC is led by Rohde, an America East all-conference second team and all-defensive team selection, who is averaging 13.8 ppg and 6.5 rpg, but has come on even stronger of late, averaging 19.8 ppg and 7.8 rpg in her last four contests. Rohde is the only player in the America East to rank in the top 10 in scoring, rebounding and assists, and UMBC is the only team in the league with four players ranking among the league's top 20 scorers, with three averaging in double figures. The Retrievers rank 17th in the country in turnovers.

**CATAMOUNT UPDATE:** Vermont (19-11, 8-8) has won three straight after Friday's 70-57 victory over No. 6 Maine in the America East Tournament quarterfinals. Freshman **Courtney Pilypaitis**, the America East Rookie of the Year, led all scorers with 23 points and added seven rebounds, seven steals and four assists, while all-rookie team member **May Kotsopoulos** scored 12 and **Amy Rosenkrantz** added 13. **Andrea Cihal** contributed eight points, nine rebounds, four blocks and four steals. The Catamounts won 14 of their first 17 games but had dropped eight of 11 before their current three-game winning streak. Pilypaitis and Kotsopoulos lead Vermont with 13.6 and 10.0 ppg, respectively.

**Who's Up Next:** A win would send UMBC to the finals on Sunday. The Retrievers have never won a conference tournament, falling 58-41 in the 2003 Northeast Conference finals, their only league championship game appearance in the Division-I era.

# RETRIEVER GAMEDAY...

**Inside the Series:** Today's game marks the ninth all-time meeting between UMBC and Vermont, and the Catamounts hold a 5-3 series advantage. The first meeting occurred on Jan. 31, 2006, a 65-55 victory for host UMBC. The Catamounts then won the next four games in the series before UMBC won, 72-63, on Feb. 12, 2006, at RAC Arena. As America East Conference rivals, the teams have met twice a year since 2004. Today's contest is the third meeting of the season for the two programs, and they have split the previous matchups, as both teams won on the road. Both teams shot below 35 percent from the field in the first game, a 46-38 victory for Vermont on Jan. 31, 2007 at RAC Arena. Both teams' point totals were season lows. Senior forward **Sharri Rohde** posted a double-double with a career-high 27 points and 10 rebounds to lead UMBC past the Catamounts, 80-72, on Feb. 20, 2007, at Patrick Gym. The 80 points were a season high for the Retrievers and the most since Nov. 23, 2004. Junior guard **Kristin Drabyn** added 18 points in the game. Vermont freshman **Courtney Pilypaitis** led the Catamounts with 22 points.

**Game Notes:** Today's game is UMBC's 31st of the season, the most the Retrievers have ever played in one year. The only other time UMBC has played 30 games was 2002-03, when the Retrievers reached the finals of the Northeast Conference Tournament. The Retrievers are 3-0 at neutral sites this year after winning both games at the UTPA Battle at the Border Holiday Tournament in Edinburg, Texas Dec. 28-29, then winning the America East quarterfinals game against Stony Brook..

# UMBC TOURNAMENT NOTES...

**Retrievers Take Fourth Shot at America East Tournament:** UMBC is playing in its fourth America East Conference Tournament since joining the league in 2003-04. The Retrievers won their first-ever game in the America East Championships in the quarterfinals on Friday with a 67-64 upset of No. 2 Stony Brook. UMBC was seeded 10th in the first two years and lost to seventh-seeded Northeastern both times, 55-30 in 2003-04 and 49-48 in 2004-05. Last season, the upstart Retrievers took the league by surprise and finished fifth in the conference but lost to fourth-seeded Binghamton, 72-66, in overtime in the quarterfinals. The Retrievers are making their first appearance in a league tournament semifinal since 2003 in the Northeast Conference, head coach Phil Stern's first at the helm. Seeded seventh, UMBC stormed past the second and third seeds in Quinnipiac and Monmouth before falling to No. 1 St. Francis (Pa.) in the finals. Those wins were UMBC's last conference tournament victories before 2007. The Retrievers have never won their conference championship or advanced to the NCAA Tournament. UMBC is 4-14 all-time in Division-I tournament play dating to 1991. The Retrievers' only other tournament victory was in 1994 as members of the Big South, when they were seeded second and defeated No. 7 Coastal Carolina before falling to No. 3 Radford in the semifinals. UMBC has been seeded as high as second twice, in 1991 in the East Coast Conference and in 1994 in the Big South. UMBC is making its third-ever appearance in the league semifinals. The Retrievers have reached the finals once during the Division-I era..

# NEWS AND NOTES...

**All-Conference Rohde:** Senior forward **Sharri Rohde** was named to the America East All-Conference second team for the second year in a row, and also earned All-Defensive team accolades.

**For Starters:** UMBC's 6-10 record in the America East is its second-best mark since joining the league in 2003-04. The Retrievers went 7-9 record in conference games last season. UMBC's six America East wins are also its second-most ever after last year's seven. The Retrievers have not played 30 games since 2002-03, setting the record for most games in program history.

**Seeing Double:** Three Retrievers - senior forward **Sharri**

**Rohde** (13.8), senior point guard **Brittnie Hughes** (11.6) and junior forward **Amanda Robinson** (10.0) - are averaging double figures in scoring. Rohde has reached double digits in 24 of 30 games this season, including the last seven. UMBC is the only team in the America East with four players ranking in the league's top 20 in scoring.

**Balanced Rohde:** Senior forward **Sharri Rohde** is the only player in the America East to rank in the conference's top 10 in scoring, rebounding and assists.

Rohde is just the third Retriever ever to amass 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 300 assists in her career.

**UMBC's Iron Woman:** Senior forward **Sharri Rohde** has started all 113 games in her career, and when she was in the opening lineup on Feb. 7 at Stony Brook, she became UMBC's all-time Iron Woman, breaking the school record for career starts.

**Join the Club:** Senior forward **Sharri Rohde** is just the 10th Retriever ever to reach both the 1,000-point and 500-rebound plateau and the first since Monica Logan in 1999. She currently ranks seventh all-time with 1,198 points and 12th with 614 rebounds. She is the 15th player in UMBC history to score 1,000 points in her career and the 13th Retriever to post 500 boards.

AMERICA EAST CHAMPIONSHIP QUARTERFINALS

Senior point guard **Brittne Hughes** scored 21 points and senior forward **Sharri Rohde** added 17 to lead the seventh-seeded UMBC women's basketball team (14-16) to a 67-64 upset of No. 2 Stony Brook (18-11) Friday afternoon in the America East Championship quarterfinals. The win is the Retrievers' first ever in the America East Tournament and just their fourth-ever Division-I tournament victory.

Stony Brook jumped out to a 16-5 lead through six minutes of play, and the teams traded field goals for the next five minutes as the Seawolves maintained their 11-point lead at 25-14 with 8:42 to play.

But UMBC scored nine straight points and ended the period on a 16-2 run to take a 33-27 lead at halftime. The Retrievers shot 75 percent (8-for-12) during that stretch, and senior forward **Heather Luttrell** scored six key points. Stony Brook turned the ball over eight times in the final 7:16 of the half.

Junior forward **Amanda Robinson** led all scorers with eight points in the first half. UMBC shot 51.9 percent (14-for-27) from the field while holding the Seawolves to just 39.3 percent shooting.

Stony Brook scored the first six points of the second half to tie the game at 33-33 at the 16:33 mark and took a 37-35 lead on two free throws by America East Player of the Year Mykeema Ford four minutes later.

The Retrievers did not score a field goal until Hughes connected on a jumper with 9:53 remaining, which sparked a 9-0 run that saw UMBC take a 46-41 lead at the 7:32 mark. Hughes scored UMBC's first 11 points of the half, tying the game with a lay-up, then drilling a go-ahead three-pointer.

The Seawolves did not go down without a fight, as senior Jessica Smith scored nine of their next 10 points to tie the game at 51-all with 2:15 to play, but Rohde made a lay-up 26 seconds later to put the Retrievers on top for good.

Ford, who was just 6-for-19 from the floor in the game, made three three-pointers to try to get her team back in it, but UMBC made 12 of 15 free throws down the stretch to cement the 67-64 victory, the Retrievers' first tournament win since the 2003 Northeast Conference semifinals, a 48-40 defeat of Monmouth.

Hughes added a career-high seven rebounds to her 21 points, while Rohde pulled down six boards and had four assists to go along with her 17 points. Robinson scored 15 and grabbed a team-best eight rebounds. The Retrievers shot 44.9 percent in the game.
