**RETRIEVER UPDATE:** The cinderella story continues for UMBC, which snapped its two-game losing streak with Friday's 67-64 upset victory over second-seeded Stony Brook, then took down No. 3 Vermont, 67-56, in the semifinals on Saturday. The Retrievers are just the third seven seed to reach the America East championship game, joining Stony Brook in 2002 and Maine in 1993. Both teams lost in the finals. UMBC would become the lowest seed ever to win the America East title; Hartford was seeded fifth in 2002. Junior forward **Amanda Robinson** posted UMBC's second straight 21-point performance in the tournament and added eight rebounds; senior point guard **Brittnie Hughes** scored 21 a night earlier against the Seawolves. The pair are averaging a team-best 18.0 ppg and 16.5 ppg, respectively, while senior forward **Sharri Rohde** has contributed 14.5 ppg. At 15-16 on the season, the Retrievers post 15 victories for the second consecutive season and tie three different teams for fourth-most wins in school history. The No. 7 seed is UMBC's second-highest seed in the America East after taking the fifth slot last season. The Retrievers were the 10th seed in their first two America East Tournaments. UMBC swept the season series from just one conference opponent - New Hampshire - and was swept by Hartford, Stony Brook and Maine in the regular season. UMBC is led by Rohde, an America East all-conference second team and all-defensive team selection, who is averaging 13.8 ppg and 6.6 rpg, but has come on even stronger of late, averaging 18.2 ppg and 8.0 rpg in her last five contests. Rohde is the only player in the America East to rank in the top 10 in scoring, rebounding and assists, and UMBC is the only team in the league with four players ranking among the league's top 20 scorers, with three averaging in double figures. The Retrievers rank 17th in the country in turnovers.

**HAWK UPDATE:** Regular-season champion and preseason favorite Hartford (24-7, 15-1) has won 15 straight after Saturday's 56-46 victory over No. 4 Binghamton in the America East Tournament semifinals and are in search of the program's third straight conference title. The Hawks were led by a career-high 13 points by **Courtney Gomez**, while **Katie Kelley** posted 12 points and eight rebounds. Led by two-time America East Coach of the Year **Jennifer Rizzotti**, the Hawks are paced by America East all-conference first team members **Danielle Hood** and **Ikea Witt**, who are averaging 13.2 ppg and 10.8 ppg, respectively. Hood stepped up her scoring in conference play, averaging 15.8 ppg in America East contests. Third team and All-Rookie selection **Diana Delva** has posted a team-best 6.7 rpg, including 7.9 rpg in league games.

**Who's Up Next:** A win would send UMBC to its first-ever NCAA Tournament berth. The Retrievers have never won a conference tournament, falling 58-41 in the 2003 Northeast Conference finals, their only league championship game appearance in the Division-I era.

# RETRIEVER GAMEDAY...

**Inside the Series:** Today's game marks the 10th all-time meeting between UMBC and Hartford, and the Hawks hold an 8-1 series advantage. The first meeting occurred on Dec. 29, 2002, a 60-47 victory for Hartford. The Hawks won the first two games in the series before UMBC won, 48-46, on Feb. 28, 2004, at RAC Arena, but Hartford has taken the last six matchups. As America East Conference rivals, the teams have met twice a year since 2004. Today's contest is the third meeting of the season for the two programs, and the Hawks have won both previous matchups, but UMBC held leads in both games. The teams met just one week ago, on March 3, as Hartford spoiled UMBC's Senior Night, edging the Retrievers, 60-56. Seniors **Brittnie Hughes** and **Sharri Rohde** scored 20 and 16 points, respectively, and the Retrievers had a 10-point lead with five minutes left in the first half. A see-saw second half had eight ties and nine lead changes, but Hartford went ahead for good with 1:17 left. The Retrievers led for most of the first half at Hartford on Jan. 17, using a 12-0 run to go up by 11 points, 21-10, with 12 minutes left. But the Hawks held a two-point advantage at halftime, and though the score was tied five minutes into the second period, Hartford ended the game with a 21-8 run and held the Retrievers to just one field goal in the final 15 minutes. Hughes is averaging 15.0 ppg against the Hawks this season, while Rohde has posted 13.0 ppg and 8.0 rpg in two contests.

**Game Notes:** Today's game is UMBC's 32nd of the season, the most the Retrievers have ever played in one year. The only other time UMBC has played 30 games was 2002-03, when the Retrievers reached the finals of the Northeast Conference Tournament. The Retrievers are 4-0 at neutral sites this year after winning both games at the UTPA Battle at the Border Holiday Tournament in Edinburg, Texas Dec. 28-29, then winning twice in the America East Tournament.

# UMBC TOURNAMENT NOTES...

**Retrievers Hope Cinderella's Slipper Fits:** UMBC is playing in its fourth America East Conference Tournament since joining the league in 2003-04. The Retrievers won their first-ever game in the America East Championships in the quarterfinals on Friday with a 67-64 upset of No. 2 Stony Brook and reach their first league title game since 2003 as members of the Northeast Conference. That season, head coach Phil Stern's first at the helm, UMBC was also seeded seventh and took down No. 2 Quinnipiac and No. 3 Monmouth before falling to regular-season champion St. Francis (Pa.) in the finals. Those wins were UMBC's last conference tournament victories before 2007. UMBC was seeded 10th in the first two years in the America East and lost to seventh-seeded Northeastern both times, 55-30 in 2003-04 and 49-48 in 2004-05. Last season, the upstart Retrievers took the league by surprise and finished fifth in the conference but lost to fourth-seeded Binghamton, 72-66, in overtime in the quarterfinals. The Retrievers have never won their conference championship or advanced to the NCAA Tournament. UMBC is 5-14 all-time in Division-I tournament play dating to 1991. The Retrievers' only other tournament victory was in 1994 as members of the Big South, when they were seeded second and defeated No. 7 Coastal Carolina before falling to No. 3 Radford in the semifinals. UMBC has been seeded as high as second twice, in 1991 in the East Coast Conference and in 1994 in the Big South.

# NEWS AND NOTES...

**All-Conference Rohde:** Senior forward **Sharri Rohde** was named to the America East All-Conference second team for the second year in a row, and also earned All-Defensive team accolades.

**Seniors Step Up:** Seniors **Brittnie Hughes**, **Sharri Rohde** and **Heather Luttrell** have stepped up their play in the America East Tournament. Hughes is averaging 16.5 ppg and 4.0 rpg with 21 points and a career-best seven rebounds against Stony Brook, while Rohde has posted 14.5 ppg, 7.5 rpg and 4.0 apg. In addition, Luttrell has tallied 5.0 ppg and 5.0 rpg, with six key points in the first half of the quarterfinals game and a clutch three-pointer against Vermont.

**UMBC's Winning Day:** Saturday was a good day for UMBC athletics, as all four teams in action were victorious. In addition to women's basketball defeating Vermont in the semifinals, men's lacrosse defeated Penn, 11-10, in double overtime, baseball took down Wagner, 5-0, and softball defeated Bucknell, 5-3, and St. Francis (Pa.), 4-2.

**For Starters:** UMBC has won 15 games for the second straight season and tie three teams for the fourth-most wins in program history. The school record for victories in a season is 20 in 1985-86.

**Seeing Double:** Three Retrievers - senior forward **Sharri Rohde** (13.8), senior point guard **Brittnie Hughes** (11.6) and junior forward **Amanda Robinson** (10.4) - are averaging double figures in scoring. Rohde has

reached double digits in 25 of 31 games this season, including the last eight. UMBC is the only team in the America East with four players ranking in the league's top 20 in scoring.

One day after shocking second-seeded Stony Brook in the quarterfinals for the program's first-ever win in the America East Tournament, the seventh-seeded UMBC women's basketball team (15-16) pulled off another upset in the semifinals, defeating No. 3 Vermont, 67-56, Saturday evening at the Binghamton University Events Center.

The lead changed hands eight times in the first half, but UMBC held a 24-17 advantage with 3:50 remaining before 11 straight points by America East Rookie of the Year Courtney Pilypaitis, including three consecutive three-pointers and a jumper at the buzzer put the Catamounts on top, 28-27, at halftime.

The Retrievers shot 45.8 percent from the floor, including 71.4 percent (5-for-7) from three-point range, while holding Vermont to just 35.5 percent from the field and 23.1 percent (3-for-13) from long distance in the half. Pilypaitis led all scorers with 12 points in the first 20 minutes.

The Catamounts held a 21-12 advantage on rebounds with eight coming on the offensive glass. Amy Rosenkrantz pulled down a game-high eight boards in the period.

Junior forward Amanda Robinson connected on a jumper at the 15:06 mark of the second half to give the Retrievers a two-point lead, 34-32, which they never relinquished. Vermont pulled to within three with 9:46 remaining, but Robinson led an 11-3 UMBC run with eight points of her own to give the Retrievers a game-high 11-point advantage, 53-42, with 5:40 to go.

The Catamounts cut their deficit to seven points on five different occasions in the final three and a half minutes, but UMBC hit 12 of 16 free throws down the stretch to seal the 67-56 victory and the trip to the finals.

"Our players wanted to win very badly tonight," head coach Phil Stern said. "We played much better in the second half. We had the will to win and that carried us through."

Robinson scored a game-high 21 points on 9-for-18 shooting, including 2-for-3 from three-point range and grabbed eight rebounds. Senior forward Sharri Rohde and senior point guard Brittne Hughes added 12 points and four assists apiece, while Rohde also posted nine rebounds.

Seven of eight Retrievers drilled at least one three-pointer in the game, as UMBC shot 56.3 percent (9-for-16) from long distance.

Pilypaitis led the Catamounts with 19 points, while freshman May Kotsopoulos added 10. Rosenkrantz posted a game-best 11 rebounds and Andrea Cihal pulled down 10. Vermont held a 40-36 rebound advantage, but UMBC out-rebounded the Catamounts, 24-19, in the second half.
