TEAM CAMP PHILOSOPHY

In its second year of existence, we hope to expand and develop Championship Preparation Team Camp into the area's best weekend of basketball! This team camp is designed to give teams a chance to compete against quality competition, improve their skills and receive top notch instruction from experienced coaches. It is our goal to help coaches find their team's potential and then maximize that potential to get the best results.

We guarantee a minimum of five games and a tournament on the final day, all at UMBC's RAC Arena, site of the Maryland state championships. Junior Varsity and Varsity teams of all divisions are welcome. Use Championship Preparation Team Camp to get ready for a crazy summer of basketball OR for the upcoming season. Either way, you are guaranteed a great weekend of basketball!

COST

The cost of the camp is **\$250** per player. This includes meals, housing, a camp t-shirt, liability insurance and a coaching clinic for the weekend. A team nonrefundable team deposit of **\$50** per player is due by May 15th.

UMBC'S FACILITIES

RAC Arena: The Retriever Activities Center, a 5.6 million dollar addition to the former UMBC Fieldhouse, was completed in the Fall of 1999. The RAC has a large multi-purpose gymnasium, two weight rooms, fitness studio, cardio balcony, new state of the art locker rooms, a full service training room for student athletes only and a new student athlete study area. The RAC Arena plays host to all of the UMBC men's and women's basketball home games.

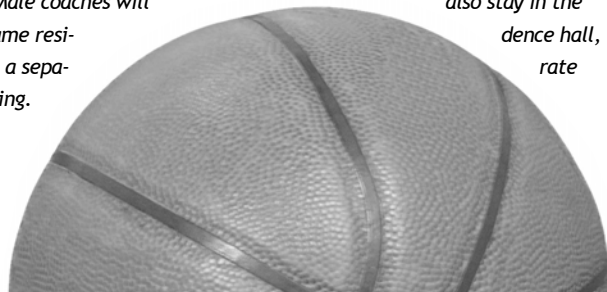
All of the games throughout the weekend will be played on full length regulation courts in the RAC, which is air-conditioned and also plays host to the Maryland Girl's High School Basketball State Championship in March.

Residence Halls: All of the teams and their coaches have the option to stay in the residence halls on UMBC's 500 acre campus. The air-conditioned suites contain two bedrooms connected by a full bathroom, allowing 4 people per suite. The residence halls are located adjacent to the dining hall, which will serve as the location for most of the meals. The residence halls are also within walking distance from the RAC Arena.

Coaches are responsible for their players in the dorms, however, additional supervision will be provided by the UMBC Women's Basketball Team. There will also be a monitor from UMBC's Residential Life on site at all times.
